The construction of the **Central Transport Hub – Solidarity Airport (CTH)** is in line with the objectives of the **European Aviation Strategy**.

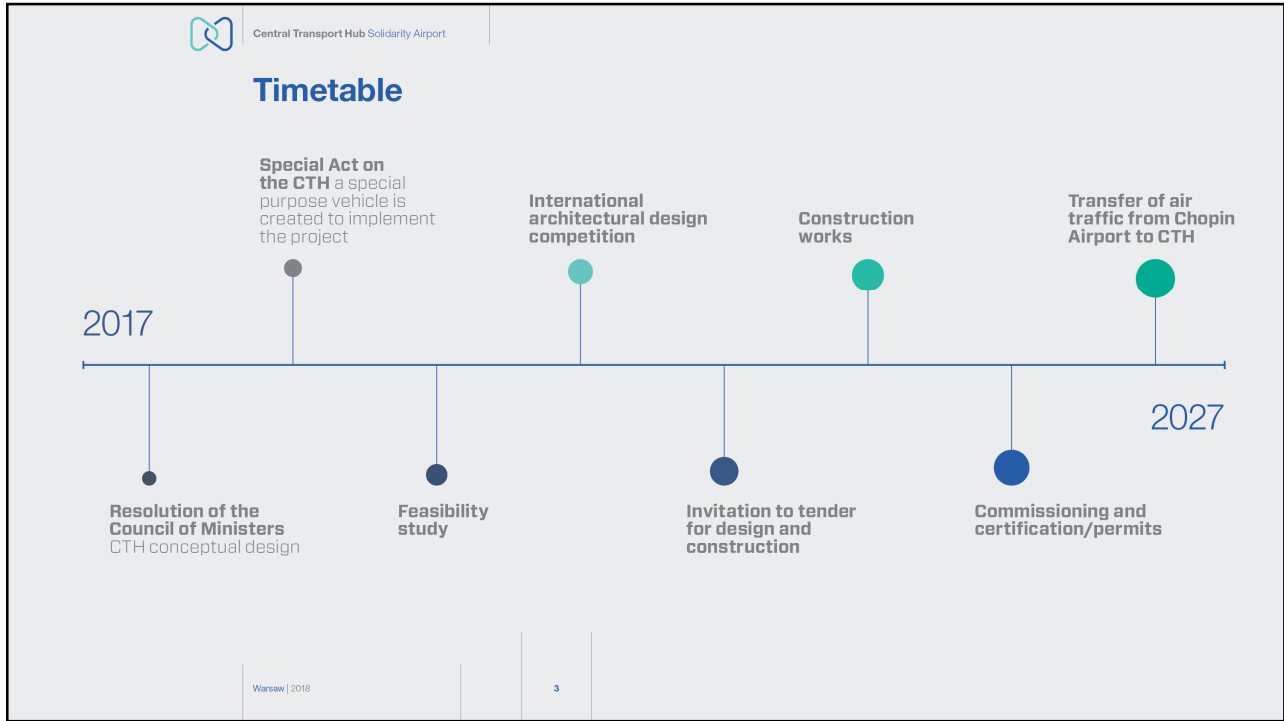

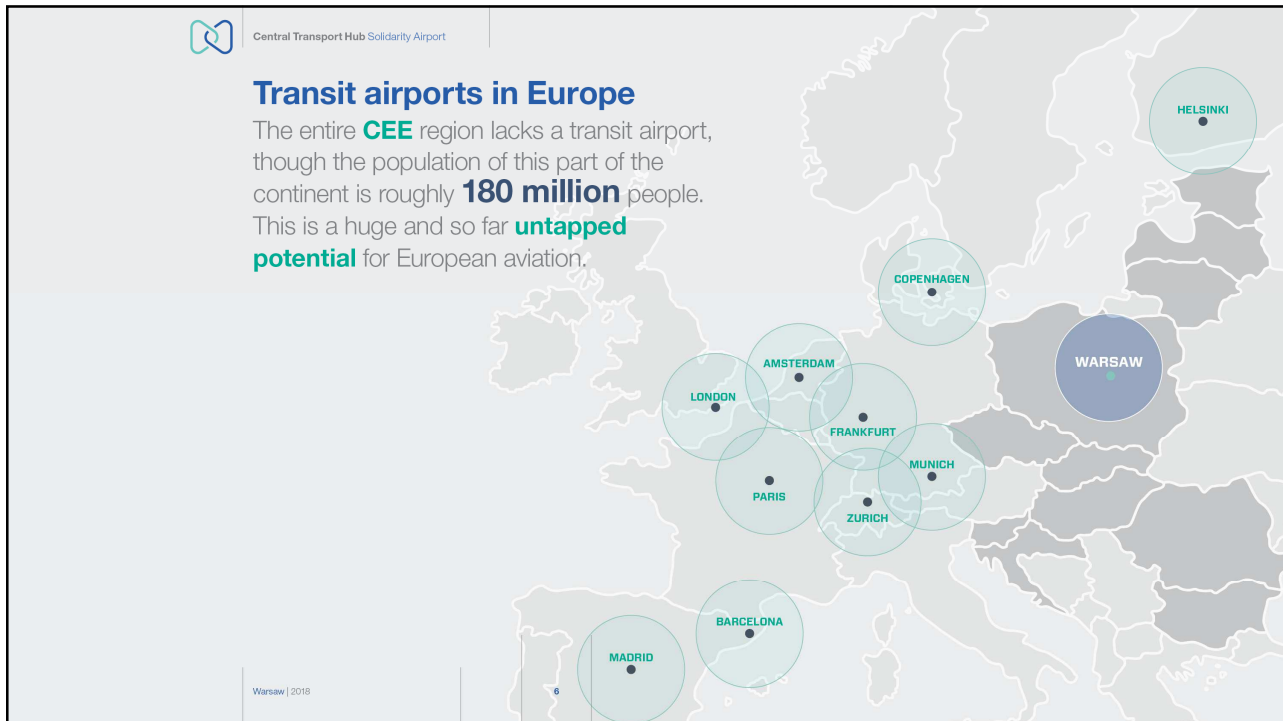
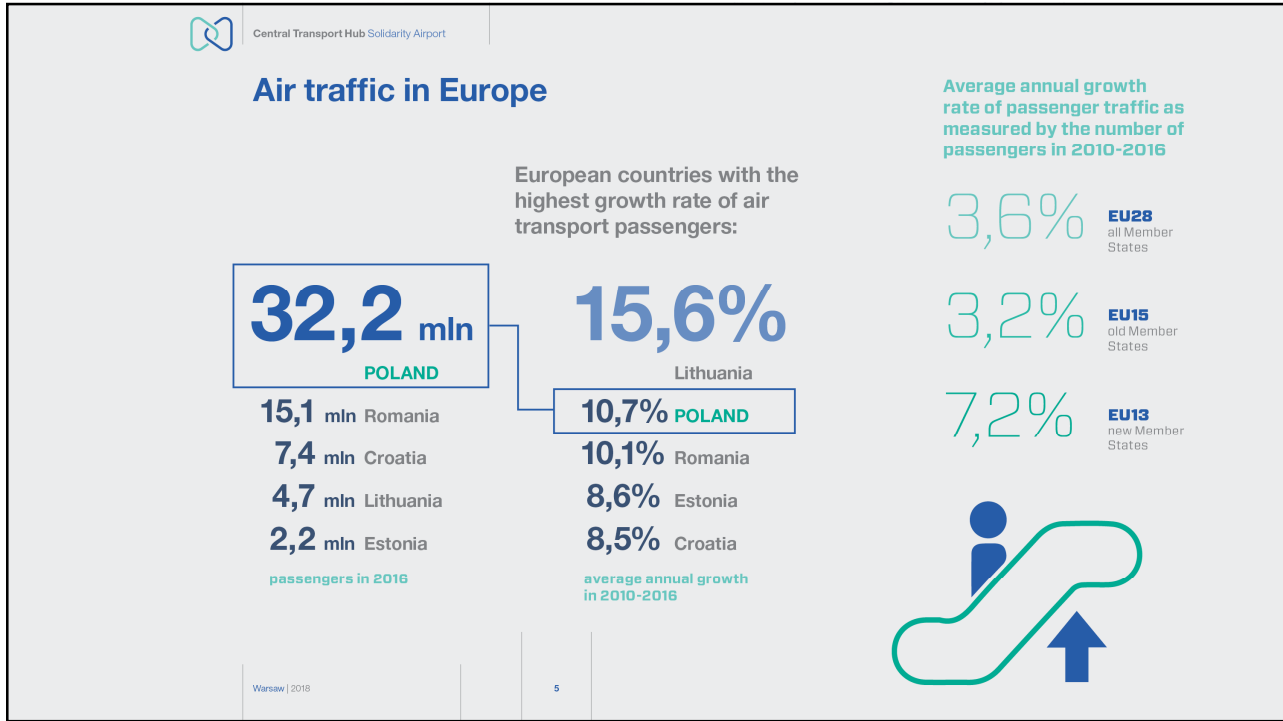
CTH will become **an indispensable link in the European network**, like Munich, Frankfurt, Paris, Amsterdam and Madrid.

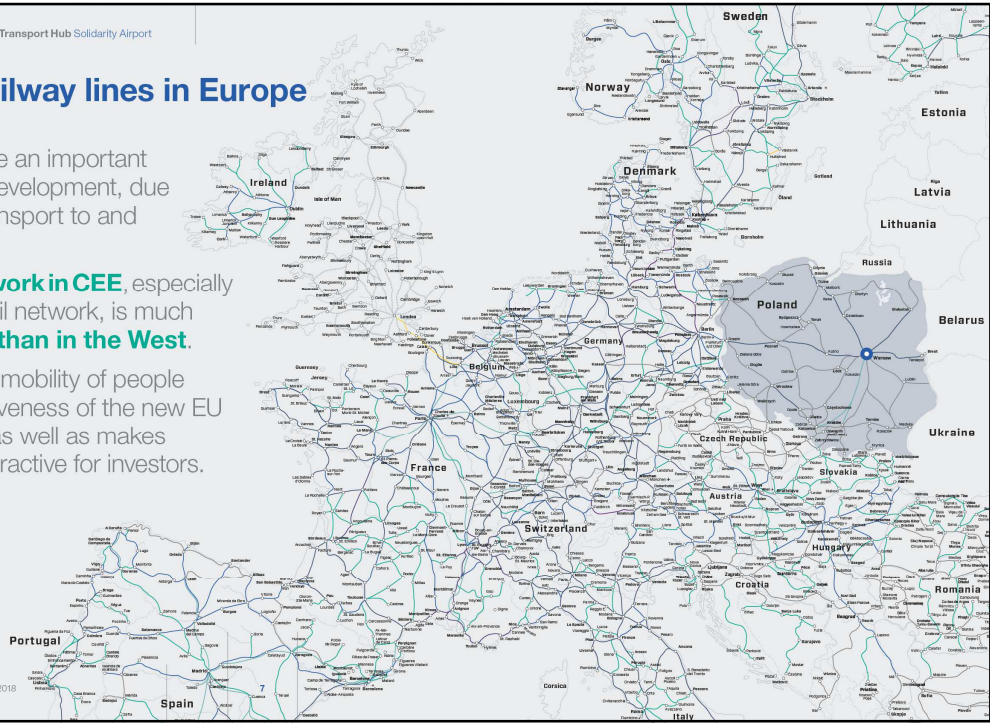
Railway lines in Europe

Transit airports are an important driver of railway development, due to demand for transport to and from the airport.

The railway network in CEE, especially the high-speed rail network, is much less developed than in the West.

This impedes the mobility of people and the competitiveness of the new EU Member States, as well as makes the region less attractive for investors.

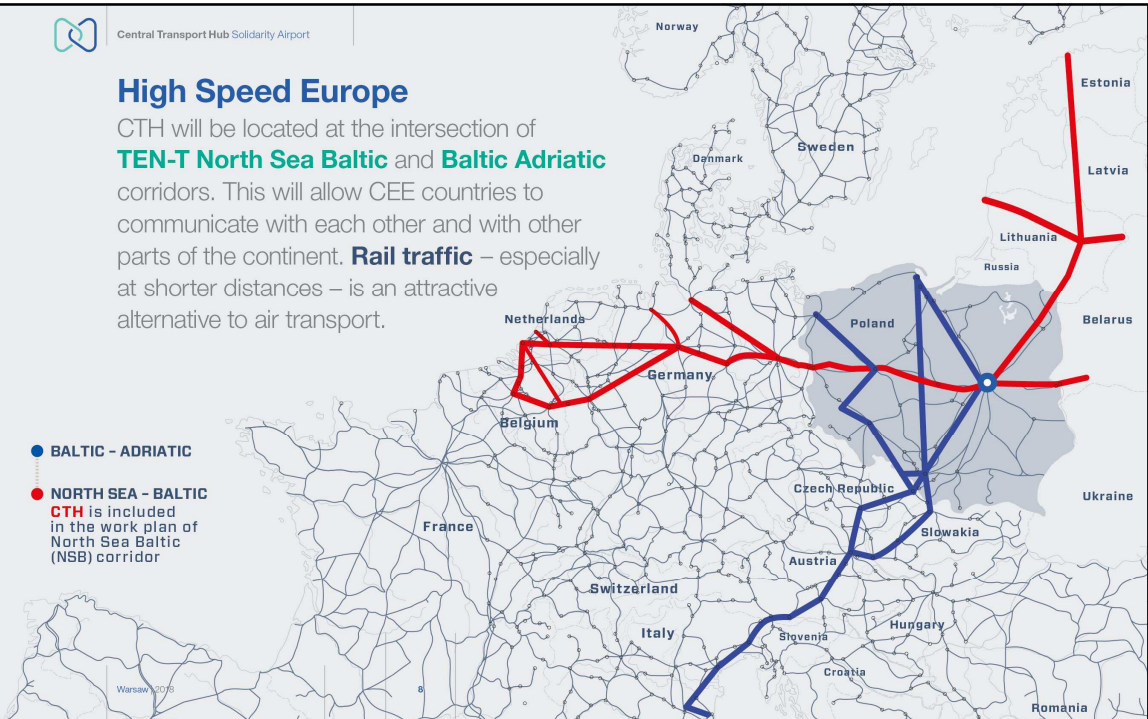

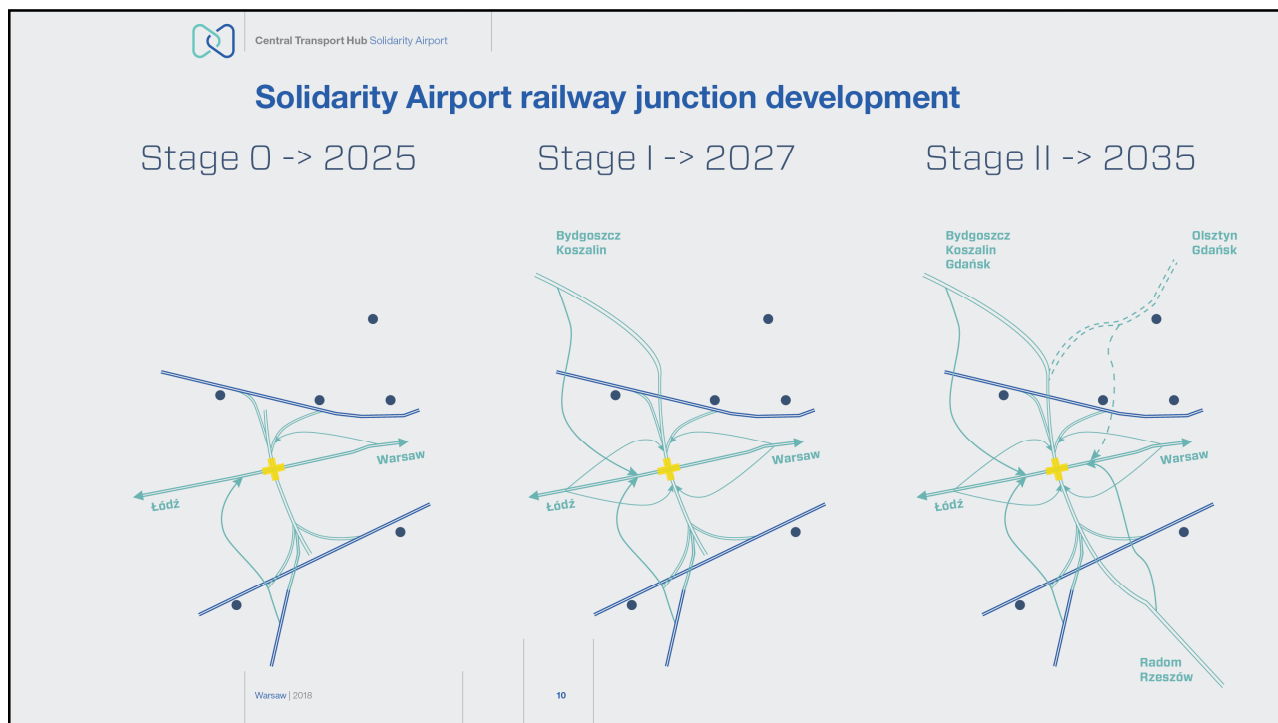
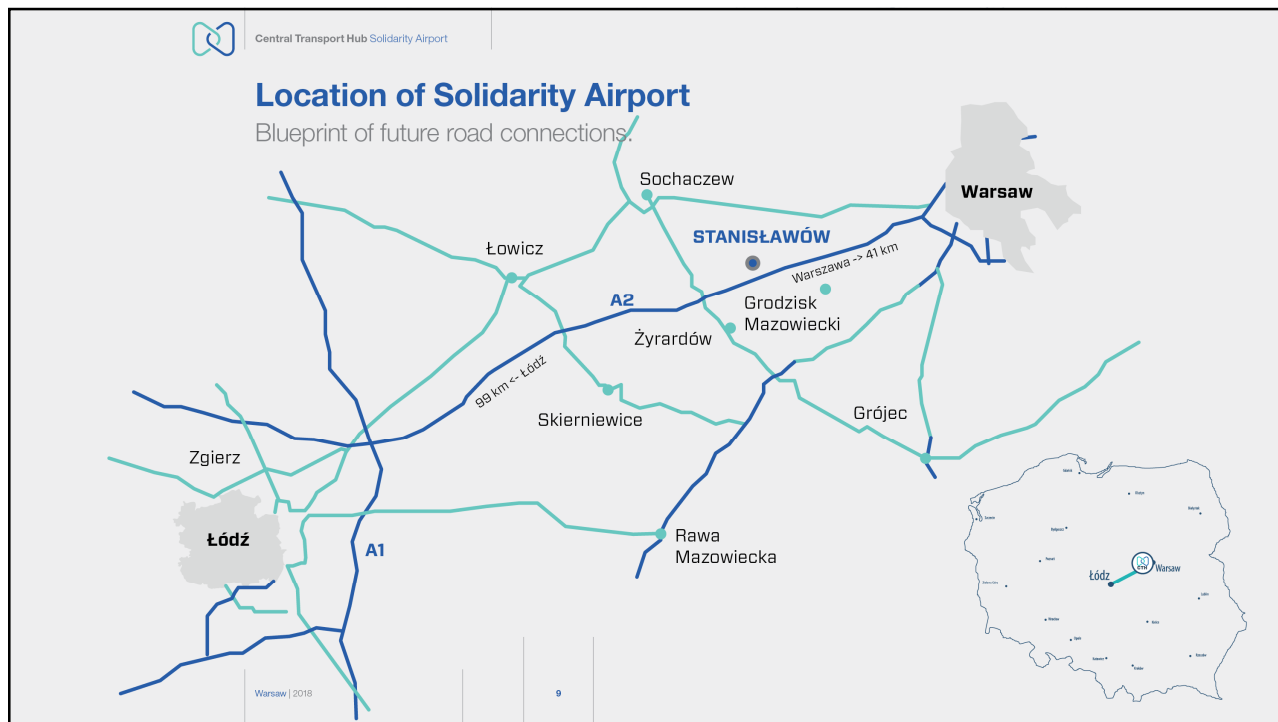
High Speed Europe

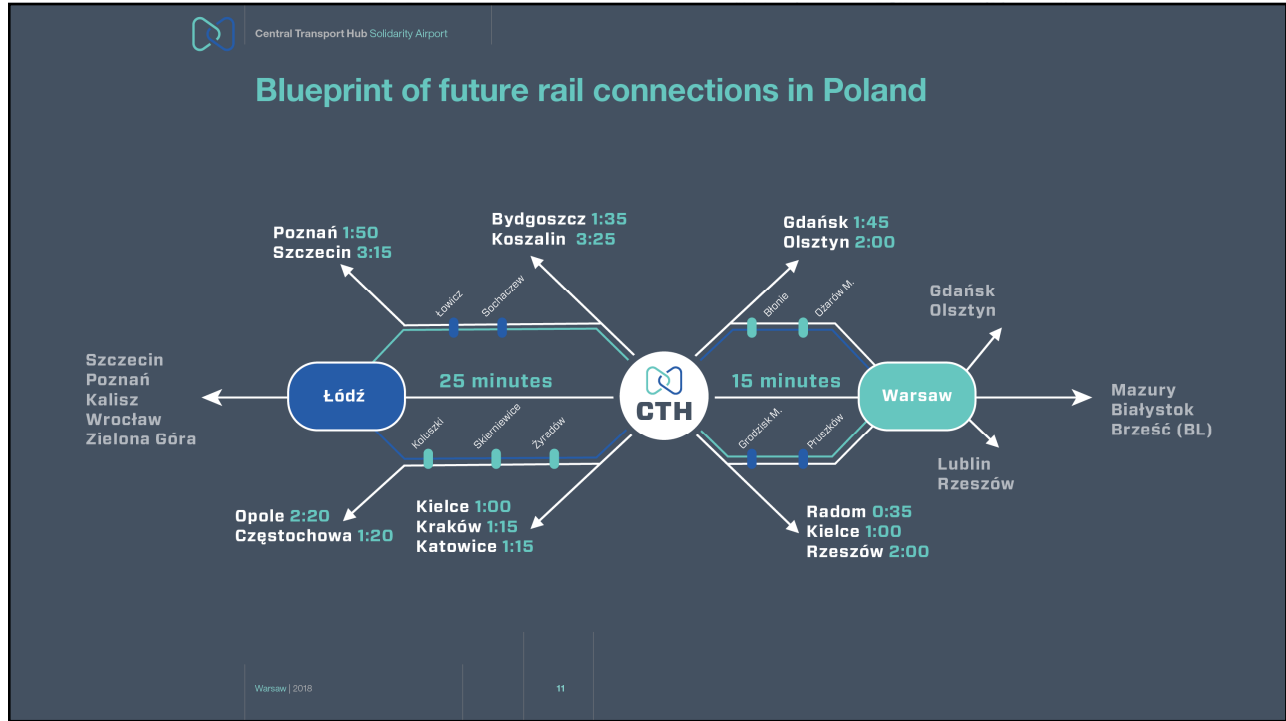
CTH will be located at the intersection of TEN-T North Sea Baltic and Baltic Adriatic corridors. This will allow CEE countries to communicate with each other and with other parts of the continent. Rail traffic – especially at shorter distances – is an attractive alternative to air transport.

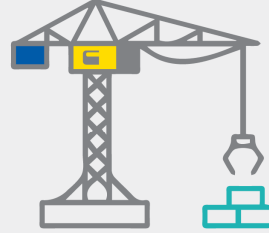

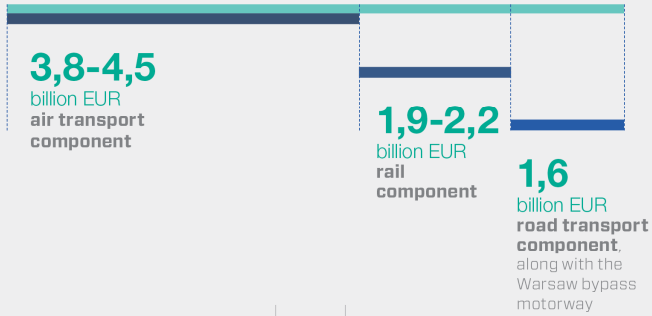
